For the convenience of foreign students, dormitories with modem facilities are available on the campus. In addition, Korean culture, customs, practices and social life exploration programs and trips are conducted


Language Training Course (D-4)

Korean Language courses are offered from basic to advanced levels. It takes six months to two years depending on the ability of the students. During Korean Language course students have opportunities personally experience Korean culture: that makes our language program distinguished in the country. Our school continues to attempt to improve the language program to meet the needs of students.

- · New students, who are qualified for admission and who have Korean visas, will be enrolled in a class according to their language ability / according to their level.
- · Passing the Test of Proficiency in Korean, TOPIK, level 3 is required for admission to the college courses.

Special Program

- During the academic year foreign students interact one to one with Korean students to deepen his/her experience with Korean lifestyles.
- In addition resident students have more opportunities to interact with lecturers, faculty and staff staying in the dormitory.
- Special program is field center education.

Admission Requirements

- High School graduate (or educational attainment equivalent to Korean High School graduate),
- For foreigners: Test of Proficiency in Korean, TOPIK level-3 is prerequisite for admission to the college courses.
- Courses are within two to four years
- Certificate and transcript are issued upon completion of a course.
- Students may continue to a four degree courses and eventually to a master's and doctor's degree in any prestigious universities in Korea.

Special Assistance

For foreigners who are full time, regular undergraduate students. scholarship and supports for tuitions fees are available based on TOPIK level,
